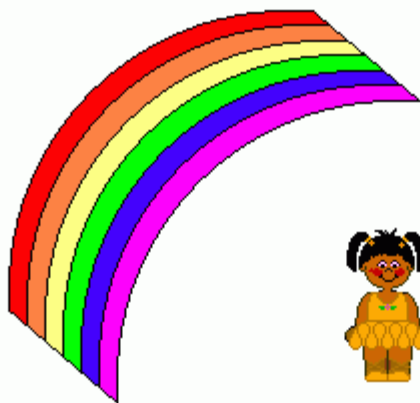

Ideas for teaching kids the alphabet:

1. Use words your kids are familiar with. Names are great. If your name is Audrey, you'll love it when your child says something like: "My mom is an A!"
2. When giving your child a choice of something to eat, ask them something like, "Do you want an "A" word (apple) or a "C" word (cookie)." If they ask for a hamburger, tell them they can have it if they know what letter "hamburger" starts with!
3. If you see a doll you want your child to pick up and put away, tell them, "I see something that begins with a 'D' that you need to pick up and put away."
4. If you are going to see Grandma, tell your child that you are going to see someone who begins with a "G."
